Take the back button and now go to the numbers above the word "grace" [5485].	
What part of speech is it? Examine what the HELPS Word Studies says.	
Can you determine yet that there are legal terms to enter into the New Covenant	
by going through Christ Jesus?	
Do you believe that God gives life to those who are spiritually dead?
